



Farmstand Land Use Permit Application

There is no cost for a Farmstand Permit.

Farmstand: A temporary accessory structure used for the retail sale of fresh fruits, eggs, vegetables, flowers, herbs, or plants. It may also involve the accessory sales of other unprocessed foodstuffs, home processed food products such as jams, jellies, pickles, sauces or baked goods, and homemade handicrafts. No commercially processed or commercially packaged foodstuffs shall be sold at a farmstand unless those products are produced on the farmstead.

- Farmstands shall be located on the owner's property and not in any right of way.
- All customers must be able to park on the farmstand owner's property.
- There may be one sign, not to exceed 18 sq ft, posted at the end of the driveway on the landowner's property. The sign shall not be illuminated.
- All local, state, and federal requirements for food production must be adhered to.
