



Site Entry Permit onto Town Roads and Driveway Land Use Permit Application

Instructions

All driveways require a Driveway Land Use Permit. Driveways entering onto a Township road also require a Site Entry Permit.

Fill out the application and return it to the Town Clerk with the applicable fee

- Driveway Land Use Permit: \$120
- Driveway Land Use Permit *and* Site Entry Permit: \$226 plus \$500 refundable deposit (as a second check)

For the **Driveway Land Use Permit**, the Planning Director will inspect the site and determine that the requirements for a Driveway Land Use Permit have been met.

For the **Site Entry Permit** the Town Clerk will provide you with a stake to be placed at the center point of where the proposed driveway will enter onto the Town road. When the stake has been placed, notify the Town Clerk.

The Road Supervisor will inspect the site and determine the requirements for the driveway, including culvert size and placement (if necessary), end slopes, and erosion control / land disturbance requirements.

When you have completed construction of the driveway, notify the Town Clerk. The Road Supervisor will inspect the driveway. If it meets the requirements as determined above, the \$500 deposit will be returned. If it does not meet the requirements, an opportunity will be provided to fix the installation. If the installation continues to not meet requirements, the deposit will be forfeited.

Driveway Setback Requirements

Side and Rear Yard Setbacks

For Zone Districts FL-1, FL-2, FFL-1	The same distance as accessory structure setbacks for the zone district (see Article V Section 3 in the Zoning Ordinance) unless there is agreement amongst all affected parties allowing a reduced property line setback.
For Zone Districts RR-1, SC-1A, SC-1B, COM-1, LIM-1, SSUR-1, SUR-1, SUR-2	One-half (1/2) of the distance of the accessory structure setback for the zone district (see Article V Section 3 in the Zoning Ordinance) unless there is agreement amongst all affected parties allowing a reduced property line setback.
