

Elden Cartway Hearing  
June 17, 2008

Present: Tim Strom, Jeff Cook, Dave Mount, Stephen Dahl, Wendy Meierhoff, Kim Maki (Andresen and Butterworth), Greg Bolf, Rona Everson, A.K. Cox, Attorney Robert Roningen.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Dave Mount made a motion to ask Township Attorney Tim Strom to moderate this evenings meeting, Wendy Meierhoff seconded. Motion passed.

Tim passed out an outline of the items required for a cartway proceeding, then spent approximately 10 minutes discussing the history and overview of cartways.

- Affidavits of Service and Postings were read; all indicated were properly accomplished and became part of the official record.
- The adjacent land owners did not receive a copy of the service but as there is no legal power to require a petitioner to do such.
- At Mr. Roningens request Registration document 203962 St. Louis County Land Record certified ownership to Thomas and Cynthia Elden 2430 Lakeview Avenue, City of Chicago, County of Cook, State of IL., was presented to the Chair. This document was filed with the Clerk for permanent record.
- Legal Description was read in its entirety: SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 5, Township 51, North Range 12 West of the Fourth Principal Meridian.

Board Findings:
