

An Ordinance for Regulation of Overnight Parking on Public and Private Land between Scenic Highway 61 and the Shoreline of Lake Superior in the Town of Duluth

Town of Duluth, St. Louis County, Minnesota

Ordinance No. 3

The Town Board of Supervisors in the Town of Duluth hereby ordains:

Article I Title:

This ordinance may be known and may be cited as the Town of Duluth Ordinance for Regulation of Overnight Parking on Public and Private Lands between Scenic Highway 61 and the Shoreline of Lake Superior in the Town of Duluth, 1976, Ordinance No. 3.

Article II.

No person shall, for the purpose of camping, lodging or residing therein, leave or park a vehicle or motor vehicle between the hours of 12 Midnight and 8:00 A.M. on public property between Scenic Highway 61 and the shoreline of Lake Superior in the Town of Duluth, or on private property between Scenic Highway 61 and the shoreline of Lake superior in the Town of Duluth without the permission of the owner.

Article III.

Violation of this ordinance is declared to be a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not exceeding three hundred dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding ninety days, or both.

Article IV.

This Ordinance is enacted by the Town of Duluth in accordance with the powers given to it under Minnesota Statutes 412.221 Subdivision 14, 1971 Laws of Minnesota Chapter 746.

Article V.

This ordinance shall take effect after its passage and publication.
